STEMbridge Consulting is seeking to hire a Lab Curator to support a select group of Bronx schools with implementing more hands-on STEM learning experiences for their students. Starting October of 2023, this is a part-time, in-person position with flexible scheduling, ranging from 5-15 hours weekly for the 2023-2024 school year. Starting pay is \$50/hour. Working in collaboration with the Executive Director and school leaders, the Lab Curator will help to assess and address the needs of schools regarding hands-on STEM learning in classes. The responsibilities of a Lab Curator include a combination of providing professional development to teachers, lab prep space cleanup and organization to facilitate a safe and efficient work space for the school, and support with weekly lab setup and cleanup for classes. While not directly interacting with students, the Lab Curator will be working closely with teachers to support them in implementing hands-on STEM learning through training and behind the scenes prep and cleanup.

Candidates must share a passion for equity and education and should believe in the vision of STEMbridge Consulting. Candidates must have a college degree and experience working either in a chemistry lab or biology lab. Strong candidates will have outstanding organizational skills, attention to detail, multitasking abilities, scientific content knowledge and laboratory skills, working knowledge of laboratory safety, and a collaborative and community-minded outlook. They should be familiar with experimental techniques used in introductory and advanced high school courses. Candidates cannot currently be employed with the New York City Department of Education (NYC DOE) and will be required to obtain clearance through the NYCDOE Personnel Eligibility Tracking System (PETS). Candidates will also be required to obtain certification from the New York City Fire Department (NYC FD) regarding supervision of a non-production chemical laboratory. Candidates with pre-existing PETS clearance and/or NYC FD Certificate of Fitness will be preferred.
